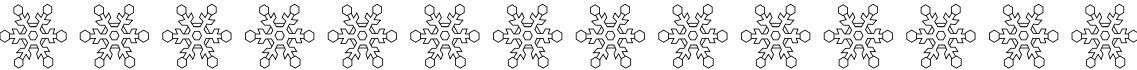

Advent Activity**

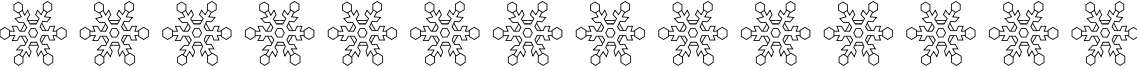
Wednesday, December 8
