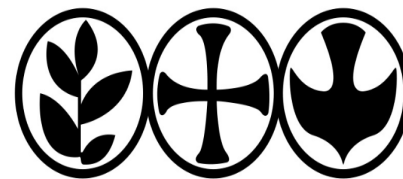

### Stewardship Moment

Legend has it that the Gauls, a warlike people of ancient times, were unhappily conquered by the Roman Empire. Christian missionaries ventured to them and converted some. When they were immersed in baptism, the warrior Gaul would hold an arm out of the water. This was peculiar to the missionaries. The reason soon was known. When the next battle broke out, the Gaul exclaimed, "This arm is not baptized," and he went out to vanquish his enemies in an un-Christian manner.

Being good stewards is about seeing ourselves as people of God who are completely wet. We may want to keep a part of ourselves dry, but living the life of the baptized, we realize we are all wet. Stewardship is giving 100% to God in all that we do. The good steward is generous in financial giving, a seeker of justice, one who is kind and humble, interested in repairing broken relationships, demonstrates care for family and the neighbor, and practices mercy. Stewardship is about pleasing God with one's whole life.
