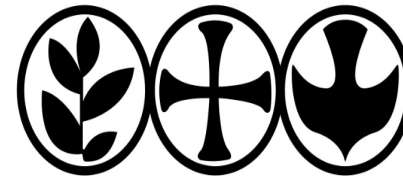

Listening to Longings and Losses

On Sunday, April 14, at the end of an abbreviated worship, Pastor Julie will lead a conversation of the spiritual practice of lament. In times of change and transition, fear can bind people from pursuing faithful action together. Listening to fears and creating space to lament losses can help. Some questions to think about include: What's one wish you have for your congregation? What's something that used to happen (or used to be true) in the congregation that you wish would return? What's one thing you fear might be lost as your congregation moves into the future? What's something that has changed that you feel is a loss in the life of the congregation? The spiritual practice of listening is a time to be thoughtful about the overall mission of the congregation. Pastor Julie will frame the conversation according to the basic structure of a lament psalm.
