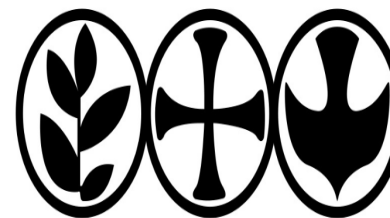

Deadly missile attack hits Ukraine children's hospital

Message from Rev. Lisa Kipp of Lutheran World Relief

When missile strikes hit a children's hospital in Kyiv, Ukraine on July 8, the Lutheran World Relief team was blocks away. They rushed to the hospital - alongside first responders - and helped to provide care and support. As you can imagine, the situation was terrifying and desperate. Our team was able to provide aid immediately to patients, their families, and others affected by the attacks across the country that day.

Our team distributed LWR quilts and personal care kits that they had on hand in Ukraine because faithful congregations like yours have packed and sent them. Thank you. They've asked me to let you know that your compassion is urgently needed in this time of crisis. The love of congregations has shown time and again that Lutherans will show up when there is a crisis.
