Fall Planning

Summer is coming to an end and plans are being made for the Fall and school year. BOLT (Building Our Lives Together), Sunday education for children ages 0-4th grade (accompanied by adult), begins on Sunday September 15th with a Backpack Blessing, music and activities during the Education Hour, 10:15-10:50 a.m. In BOLT children will learn Bible stories, the church season, and how to connect faith and life. There will be singing, stories, crafts and activities. Worship prior to BOLT is encouraged.
