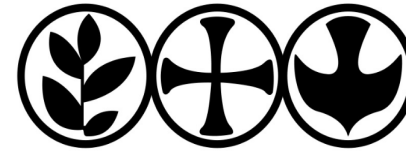

Is Lay School of Ministry (LSM) for you?

Have you ever thought about pursuing theological education which could inform your life and service in the church and community? The Lay School of Ministry might be for you. The Northwest Synod of Wisconsin has provided this education for 30 years. The school meets on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings, the second weekend of the month from September through May.

LSM is an educational ministry of our synod, which assists lay people to a deeper Christian identity and participation in the mission of the whole church. The curriculum and educational objectives of the Lay School of Ministry emphasize the baptismal vocation of all Christians. Courses are designed to help students develop a deeper understanding of the Bible, Worship, Spirituality, Christian History, and Lutheran Theology. Students complete this course work in two years. Graduates are then eligible to attend the Continuing Education classes.

Now is the time to register for the 2024-2025 year at www.layschoolofministry.org. Tuition costs for the year are \$475 with costs for textbooks up to \$ 250. For more information, go online or speak to Pastor Julie. The classes are conducted at Our Saviour's Lutheran in Chippewa Falls. Since the COVID years, the Lay School has shifted to meeting via Zoom during the months of December, January, February and March. They also offer a hybrid model for the other months for those persons who cannot meet in person.
