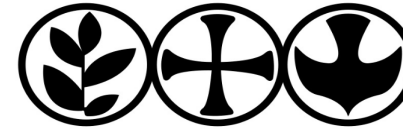

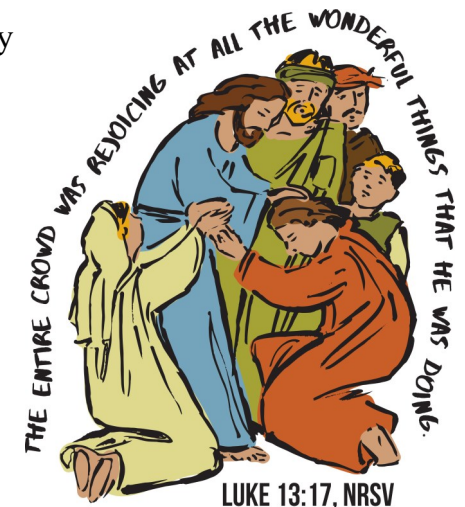

Service of Healing

The worship today will include an order for the Service for Healing. Several of the gospel stories which are read in worship each year are ones where people are healed. Today's gospel reading contains two unique stories recorded in Mark where Jesus seems reluctant to be in the spotlight, yet he finds that God's grace is present, creating faith in a persistent mother and in the friends of a man unable to speak or hear. Jesus, seeing the presence of need and faith in his power to heal, acts by granting healing.

The Service for Healing during the worship today is a time for you to boldly approach God with a request for healing. All people are welcome to come forward for the laying on of hands, anointing of oil, and prayer as we all stand in need of healing, be it physical, mental, emotional, or social. We all are in need of grace and mercy, forgiveness and renewal. As we say at communion, we say today, "All are welcome."
